Dear Sir:

This is to inform you that we have reviewed the information you sent for an injection adhesive - Hilti HTE 50.

Based on the data compiled these materials qualify for addition to our Designated Sources for Materials List # 9.30.25

Your company's name and address will be included in the next published revision of the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario's DSM Lists #9.30.25 after successful registration with The Road Authority.

The Road Authority (TRA) is now managing MTO's DSM database and co-ordinating applications from proponents. A company, their products and contact person must be registered with TRA to have their products listed on the MTO's DSM. In order to maintain listing on the DSM, an approved company must maintain registration in good standing with TRA.

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The application must clearly state that the proponent requests product inclusion on the MTO's DSM; otherwise the processing will be limited to product classification and listing on TRA only.

The Ministry of Transportation of Ontario tests and/or evaluates products, services and processes in the context of its own specific needs only. Ministry approval does not constitute a general or specific endorsement, and must not be used by the recipient of such approval to promote sale of a product, service, and/or process. Any violation of this prohibition may result in the withdrawal of any approval granted.

The acceptance of a product is linked to a particular manufacturing facility and is granted for a specific product configuration/material composition. Any product redesign or a change in the manufacturing process/location requires re-evaluation of the product's acceptance. For some products periodic re-testing is required. Severe or ongoing quality problems may lead to product de-listing from the DSM.

Please NOTE that we are in a process of revising prequalification methods and procedures and your company might be asked in the future to perform additional testing at which time some products may not meet our new requirements and will be removed from DSM list # 9.30.25

One of our requirements is an ongoing use of your product by the Ministry, therefore prolonged absence (exceeding 36 months) will be considered as a ground for removing it from our DSM list.
